### DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The “Hospitals and faculties together for prosperous and scientific based healthcare” (ProCare) project is an international project financed with European funds and is comprised of four countries: Slovenia, Ireland, Spain and Italy.

In contemporary healthcare, nurses are users and generators of evidence to underpin their practice. As users of evidence, they are able to locate evidence and critically appraise it. As generators of evidence nurses are able to research their own practice and translate those findings into practice. The overall aim of the ProCare project is to promote these competencies by supporting the development of capacity and capability and to enhance cooperation between higher education institutions (HEIs) and hospitals. This has the ultimate aim of providing care to patients and families consistent with the best available evidence thereby improving patient outcomes.

### TOPICS

The Scientific Committee is pleased to invite researchers to submit their abstracts to be presented at the ProCare International Final Conference.

The organizers welcome the submissions of abstracts for original contributions to the field in these thematic areas:

- Experiences of cooperation between HEIs and hospitals that have facilitated exchange, flow and co-creation of knowledge
- Nursing research experiences carried out by nurses working in the clinic and generating new evidence

## GENERAL INFORMATION – ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

The abstract should be a maximum of 300 words and should describe the experience according to the requested thematic areas.

The abstract should use IMRaD structure (Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion - max 300 words).

| <b>Keywords</b>  | Max 5 Keywords   |
